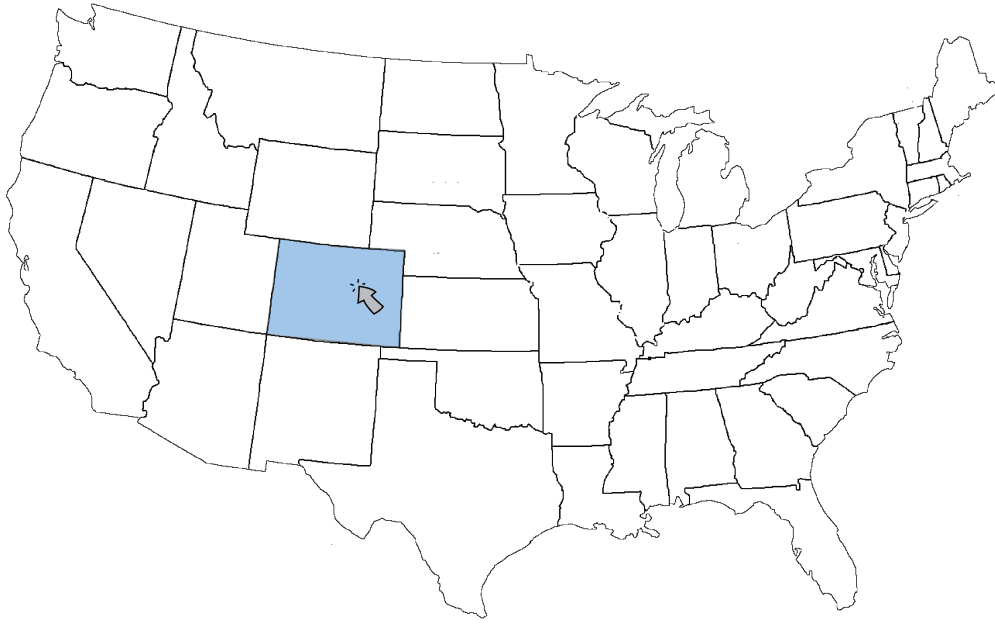
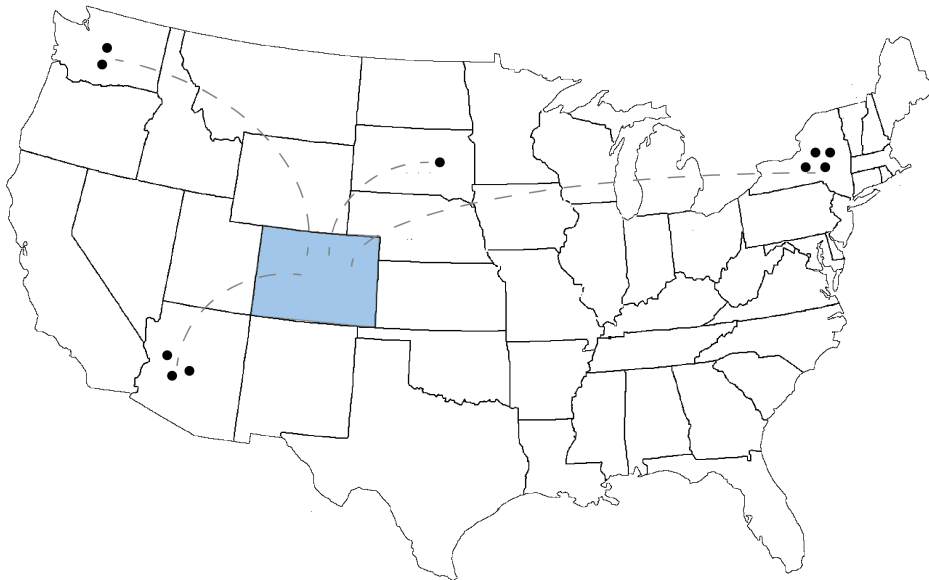


The United States Migration Explorer allows users to explore migration patterns to and from the states.

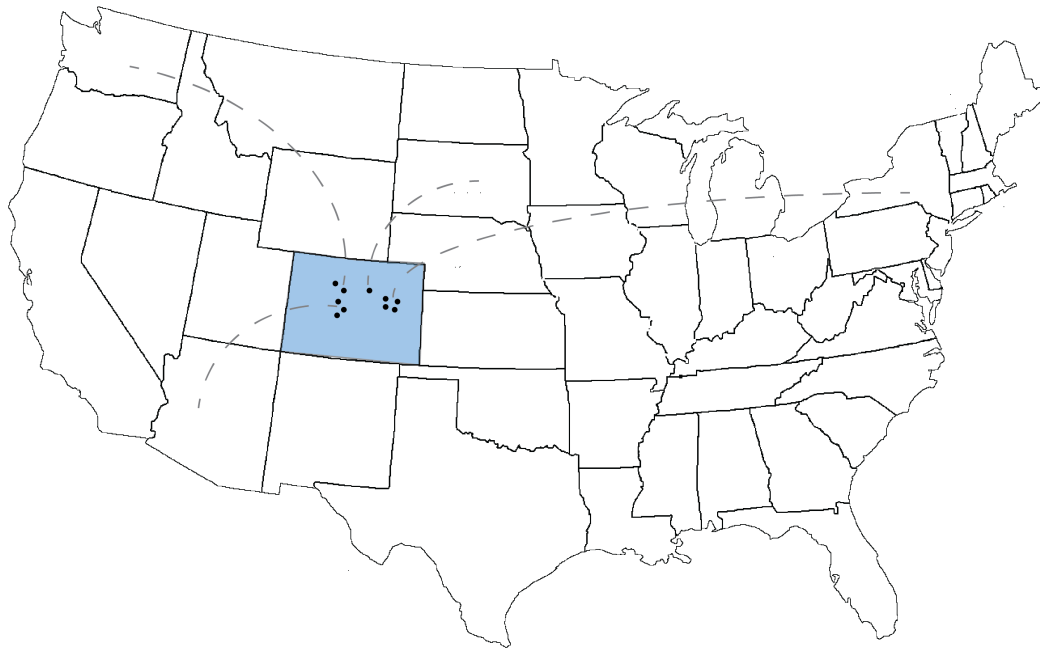
Since we're visualizing geographic data, let's make an interactive map. As a user clicks on a state



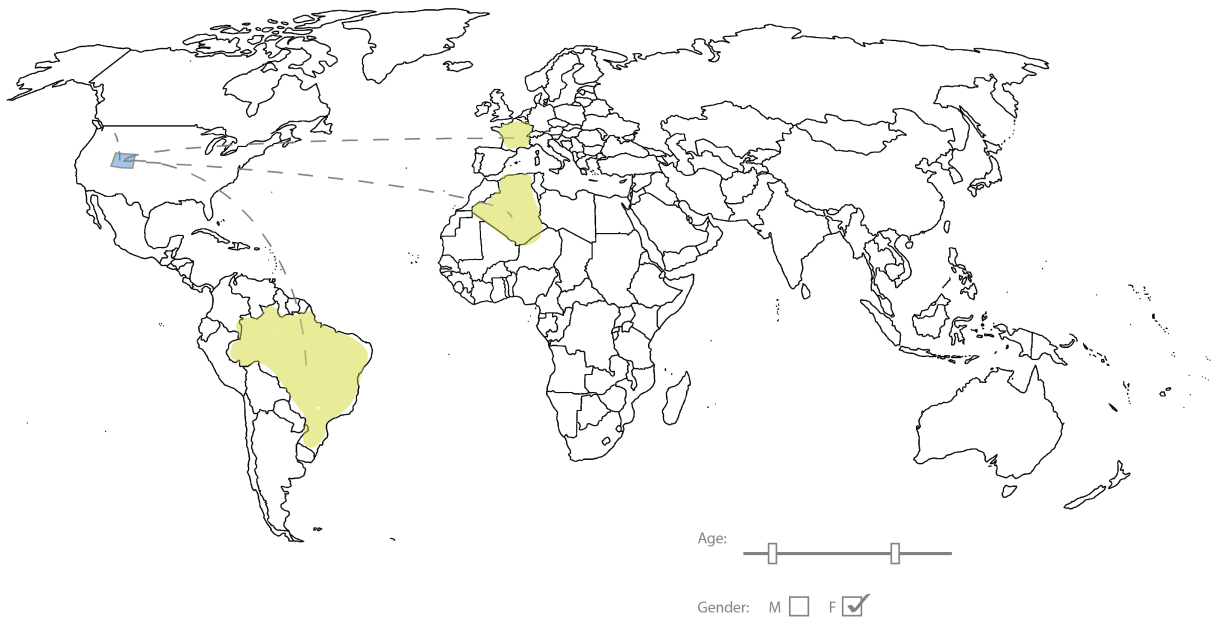
pathways appear from the states from which people moved to the selected state.



Animation shows dots – representing some x number of people – traveling from source states to the selected destination state.



Users may zoom out to a view of the world to see the countries where people came from as well.



Users may also filter the data based on age (via slider) and gender. Additionally, users may toggle modes to select destination states – where did inhabitants of the selected state come from? -- or sources states – which did inhabitants of the selected state go?
